However, membership organisations such as the Association of Reflexologists, and the Freelance Hair and Beauty Federation generally offer Continuing Professional Development opportunities or can signpost learners to local providers</p> <p>Kingston College is an Association of Reflexologists Accredited Training School</p> <p>Those interested in supervision and management could consider progressing to more general Business or Marketing courses at Levels 4-6.</p> <p>Self employment courses would be useful for those wanting to establish their own salons.</p>
